


# How do I view my assignment?



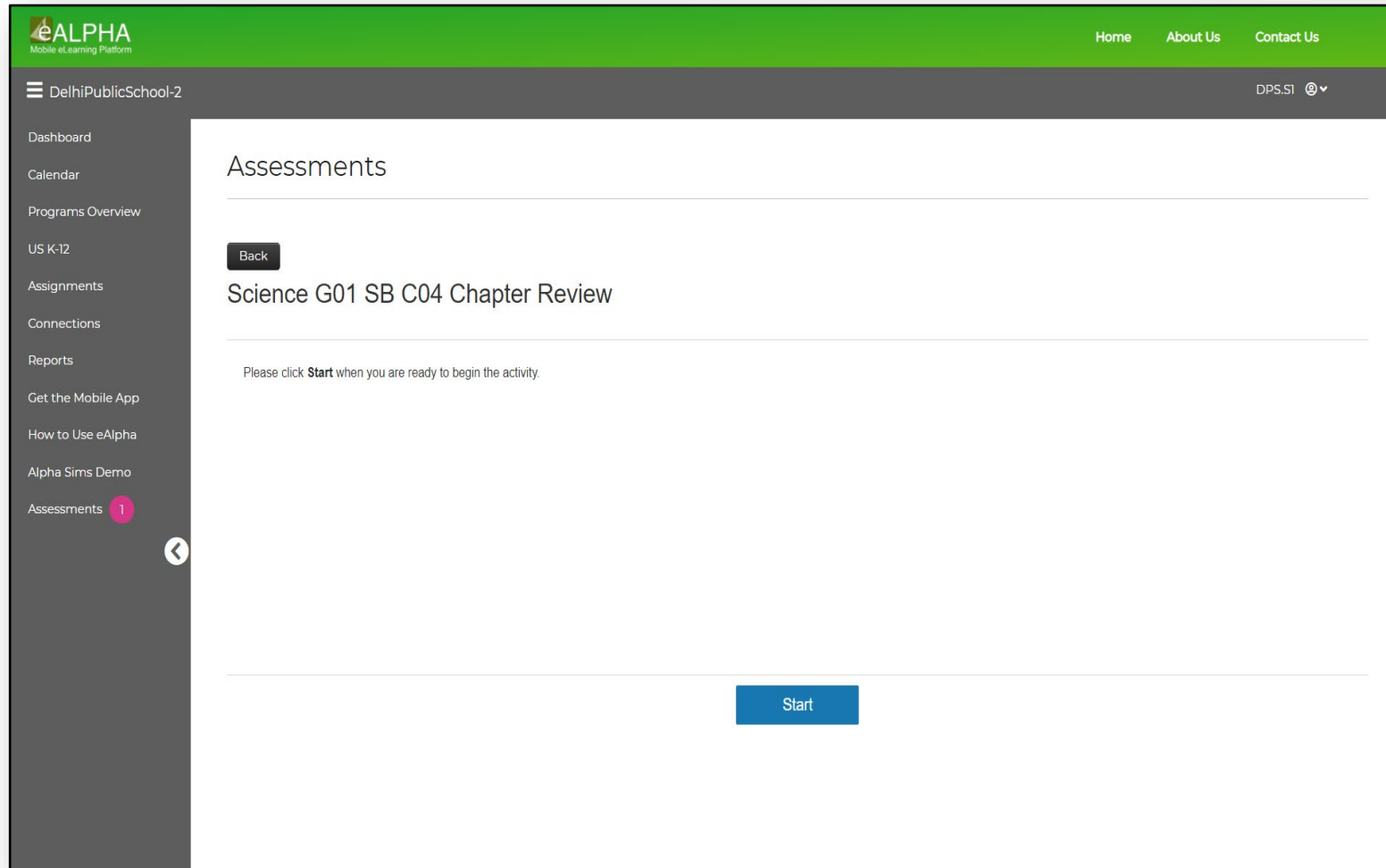

# How do I take a test?


# Students can take the assessment by clicking on the Assessment Name link



## Students can:

- Use the timer to count the time.
- See items full screen.
- Pause the assessment.
- Save and continue where he or she left off.
- Navigate back and forth between items.
- Review his or her answers.

# Students can see their progress





# Students will know if they skipped a question



## After completing the final item:


- If any items remain unanswered, students will see a pop-up that more answers are required.

Students can see which item they skipped over without answering






